COLORADO RELAY SERVICES

Relay Colorado is a free public service that enables people with hearing or speech loss who use a teletypewriter (TTY) or other assistive device to communicate with standard telephone users. The conversation is relayed between the two parties by a specially trained Relay Colorado Communications Assistant. Relay Colorado is available 24 hours a day 365 days per year.

Relay Colorado offers many ways for you to communicate with anyone that has a phone. Services include standard text telephone (TTY), Spanish relay, voice caller, speech-to-speech, hearing carry over, voice carry over, relay conference captioning, telebraille and several internet based relay services such as IP relay, web captel and video relay.
